Subject: Notice of Fisheries Offsetting Activities 2026

To Whom it May Concern:

BW Gold is writing to inform land users of planned Fisheries Offsetting activities that will be undertaken on private land at Murray Creek and Greer Creek in support of Federal Decision Statement (FDS) Condition 3.11 and 3.12 and Fisheries Act Authorization. The location of the planned offsetting activities is shown in the attached Figure 10-1.

Environmental monitoring activities are planned at Murray Creek and Greer Creek as early as mid-May 2026 and continuing through to the end of 2026. These activities will include wildlife surveys, invasive species surveys, and reptile and fish salvage operations. A low increase to noise levels is anticipated, as activities will utilize light duty vehicles.

Civil construction-related activities are planned at Murray Creek and Greer Creek to begin as early as late July and will continue through the end of 2026. These activities will include earthmoving, excavating, and temporary storage of materials using heavy equipment such as excavators, rock trucks, dozers, and light duty vehicles. Elevated noise and vibration levels can be expected during this phase of work.

Riparian rehabilitation activities are planned at Murray Creek and Greer Creek to begin in mid-August continuing through to the end of September 2026. Activities will include planting along prepared rehabilitation areas. Noise levels during this phase are expected to be low to moderate, with limited use of equipment; however, some planting activities may require the use of a mini-excavator.

Pending progress at the Murray Creek and Greer Creek sites, work at other locations shown in Figure 10-1 may occur in late 2026 or 2027, subject to advance notification.
